Resumes online (150,000,000) equal to the US workforce




1 billion downloads (200 million gamers) have downloaded Angry Birds, resulting in 400 bn birds having been flung, equivalent to the world's total bird population


Economic Impact of Digitization












ICT Sector Development Building Blocks








ICT Sector Development Tensions
